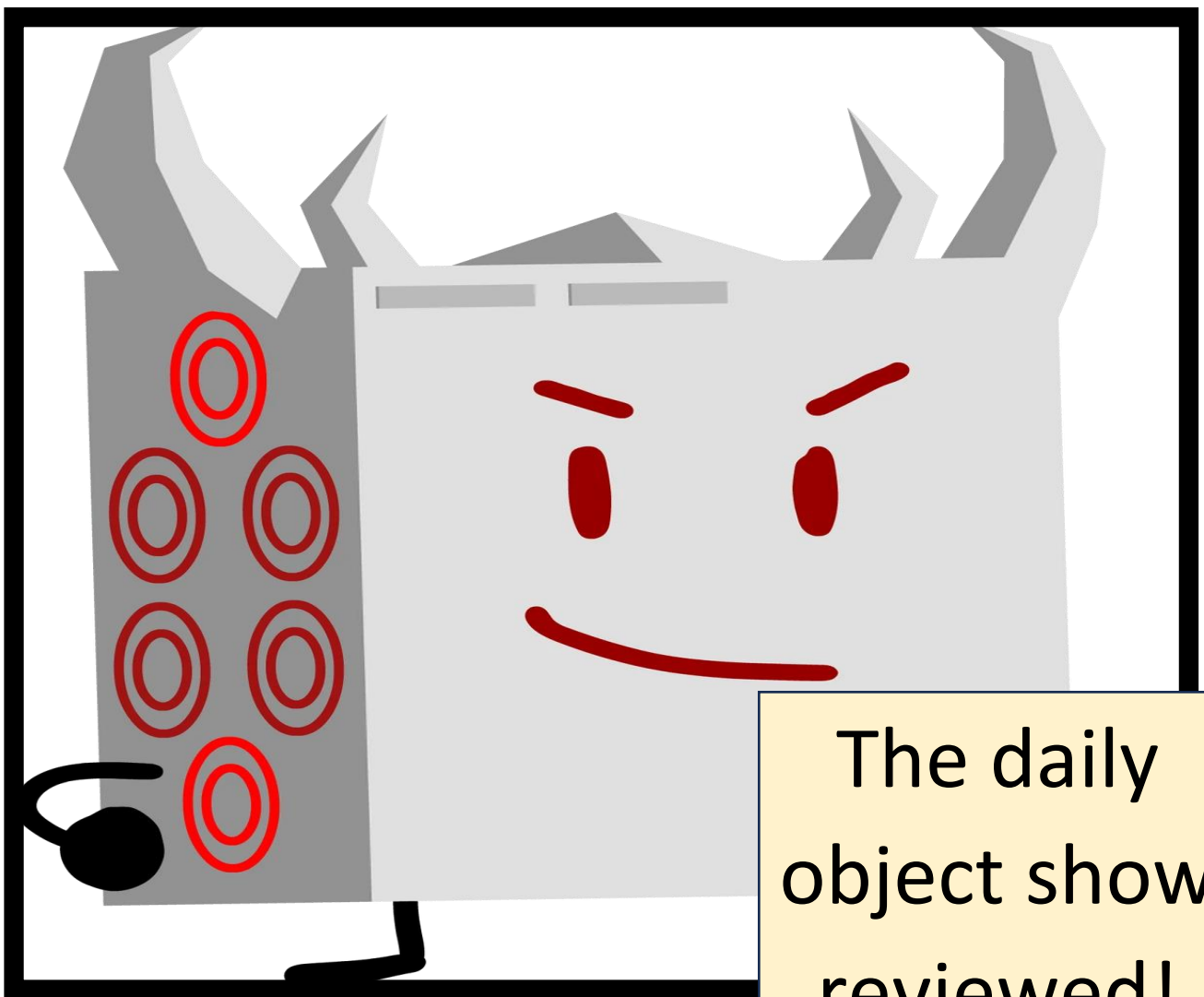

Jujutsu kaisen season 2 fully reviewed!



This season was an absolute banger!

Jujutsu kaisen was definitively, my anime of the year for 2023. Stunning animation, great writing, perfect characters and more.

The season starts with the hidden inventory /premature death arc and goes up until the end of the shibuya incident arc.

The fights are certainly a highlight of the season. Some of the best are Yuji vs choso, sukuna vs mahoraga, toji vs megumi, toji vs Gojo rounds 1 and 2 and yuji+Nobara+todo vs mahito.

I also have to praise the voice acting. Both the sub and dub have great voice acting with the highlights being yuji (sub), Gojo (dub), todo (sub and dub) and mahito (sub).

The best episode is definitely a tie between, right and wrong part 3 (Todo coming in to save yuji was so cool and from how he doesn't just deny how yuji feels in the moment to how he keeps confusing mahito with boogie woogie even after mahito fully realises how the technique works, he keeps showing how great his character is) and metamorphosis (yuji's "I am you" speech was perfectly done and it is so satisfying to see mahito in complete shambles and yuji being the predator for once.)

Overall, this season was a 10/10 literally one of the best seasons of any anime ever. Can't wait for season 3.

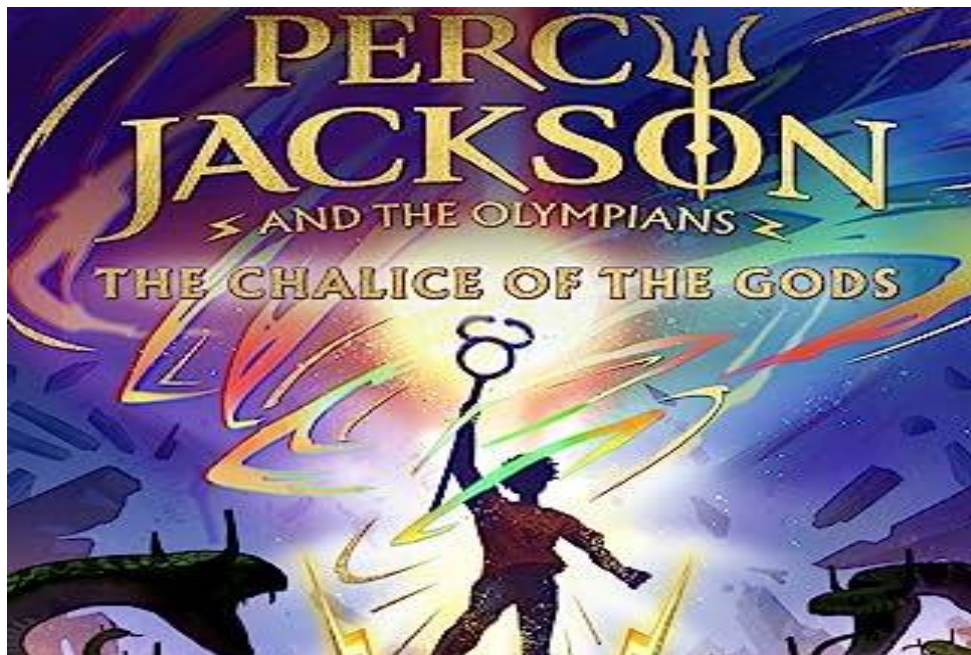
